

Teaching Staff

This is an excellent opportunity for a newer teacher to gain additional experience and add to their resume, or for a more experienced teacher to not only gain additional experience, but also have access to opportunities for professional growth in the areas of choreography and performance. It is a great job for someone who loves sharing their art form with others, and being part of a team that together help to create multiple positive experiences for our community.

Potential faculty members should possess several years of technical training in their area of expertise. In addition, they should have prior experience in teaching. Prior experience in choreography and performance is a plus. While we do accept dancers who have not taught before into our internship program, that is a different application process.

We are always open to receiving letters of inquiry from teachers of a diverse variety of technical styles, so if you are a hooping instructor or Poi dance instructor please feel free to write us.

We are currently looking to expand our ballet program, and replace a hip hop teacher who left for college:

Ballet Teacher for ages 9 and older, for Levels 2 – 5 of our syllabus, which has been shaped in large part by ABT. (If you are not familiar with ABT syllabus, we will educate you as to our system) Our staff also has training in RAD and other styles, so we welcome a broad range of training.

Hip Hop Teacher for ages 8 and older, one – two classes per week

What's the process for teaching at the Dance Workshop?

- Please submit a letter of inquiry with resume and two references to office@trokanski.com and please put "Applying for Teaching Position" in the subject line of the email
- You will be contacted to come in for an interview after speaking with Pamela on the phone and, during the interview, she will explain the process which will include an "audition" teaching class.

Teachers might teach 1 – 10 classes / week, depending on their schedules, the senior faculty members' schedules, availability of studio space, and student enrollment. Classes may be canceled if no one signs up for them.

If there is student interest, teachers are expected to choreograph a piece for the Annual Student Concert.

Pay rate

is hourly and ranges from \$16 - \$40 / hour, dependent on level of teaching experience and number of students in the class.
