★ ***On Thursday:***

Check-in for rehearsal in the LOBBY.

Please be sure to check the program in the lobby to make sure your name is spelled correctly, And pick up your T-shirt.

★ ***Friday & Saturday:***

Check-in for Dress Rehearsal & Performances in the GREENROOM.

Please be sure to be in costume, hair/makeup, and in the spot for your (first) group by the call time.

Friday, June 5 - DRESS REHEARSAL – Be sure to check-in with the Backstage Manager (in the Greenroom)

★ **Dancers should arrive in full costume, hair, and makeup** ★

3:45	The theater will open and dancers may start arriving
4:15	Dancer call time. Dancers should be with their groups and ready to go on stage
4:45	Dress Rehearsal begins
	Finale – After the Dress Rehearsal, the groups in the finale will stay to practice
Friday Only	Dancers may leave after their last piece, or they may watch from the audience
	★Please Note: This is the only opportunity for the dancers in the second half to watch the first half in person (of course, they'll also be able to see the whole show in the video)

Saturday, June 6 - PERFORMANCE DAY – There will be 2 performances: 1pm and 6pm

11:30 – 12:00	All dancers arrive (in costume & makeup) for 1pm performance (Must be ready by 12pm)
4:30 – 5:00	All dancers arrive (in costume & makeup) for 6pm performance (Must be ready by 5pm)

Please note: *It is too chaotic to have dancers coming & going during the performance, so dancers should only leave during the intermission (1st-half dancers) or after the show is over (2nd-half dancers).*

Tickets: Ticket sales start next week at the Dance Workshop. There should be plenty for everyone who wants them. They will also be for sale in the Brunelle Theater lobby during rehearsals on Thurs & Fri. And the box office will open 30 minutes before each performance on Saturday.

★Dancers in the first half have the option to purchase a half-price ticket for the second half only (but theater etiquette does not allow costumes in the theater, so please bring a change of clothes)

Extra Info:

- **Students may begin arriving as soon as the theater is open, and must be in full costume, hair, and makeup and in the designated area for their group no later than the call time.**
 - This will enable the Backstage Manager to check-in everyone in a timely manner.
- **Backstage changing areas are relatively few, so please arrive in costume and makeup if possible.**
 - HOWEVER, if your child is in the first half of the show and has a student participation ticket for the second half, please bring a change of clothes. Dancers will not be admitted to the seating area if in costume.
- **Dancers in multiple pieces will need to change costumes, so please, NO PHOTOS IN THE GREENROOM.**
- **Please no liquid other than water, and no sticky/messy snacks/activities backstage (NO GUM, crumbs, etc.)**
 - No hairspray backstage. Instead, use it at home or outside.
 - Also, due to allergies, we ask that you do not bring foods with nuts or nut products to the theater.
 - Each group should leave their area clean after each rehearsal and performance.
- **Backstage supervising parents should wear dark colors, to blend in with the backstage/stage wing area. Also, supervising parents should have a phone to call anyone in their group who has not arrived on time, but please note and plan ahead: Phones and/or purses are not allowed in the backstage area, so please leave your belongings in the Greenroom when you take your group to the stage.**
 - Dancers' props should not be handed out until the whole group is in the wings, right before going on stage.
- **Please Note:** Supervising Group Parents must stay with their group until all of the students have been picked up by parents. (1st half dancers – Intermission / 2nd half dancers – Right after the show ends)
- Please leave unnecessary valuables at home (or in your car) so you do not risk losing them.
